### **How to Prevent Carbon Monoxide Exposure:**

- Install and maintain a carbon monoxide detector in accordance with the manufacturer's Instructions.
- Check and maintain proper ventilation of appliances and chimney flues.
- Clean or replace furnace filters regularly.
- Do not block air intake areas near appliances.
- Do not use a natural gas space heater or range to heat your home.
- Do not start your car, lawn mower, generator or any combustion engine in a closed garage.
- Do not operate a natural gas or propane grill in an enclosed area.
- Notice the color of the flame on a natural gas appliance.
  A yellow flame instead of a blue one is a warning sign that the appliance is not operating or vented properly.
- Have a qualified contractor inspect your heating and cooling equipment annually.

### Remember to check your email

It is very important that you check your assigned work email at least once per week if not more. If you do not know what your email address is or you do not know how to access it, please let someone at the office know and they will show you. Besides pay stubs, there are other important emails that are sent out.

### DID YOU MISS OPEN ENROLLMENT FOR MEDICAL INSURANCE?

Open enrollment for Blue Cross Blue Shields was in November however,

you are not completely out of luck if you are still interested in signing up for medical insurance.

If you qualify for InsureOK, you may still be able to get enrolled in our group medical plan.

### **W4 Information**

IF you plan on filing "Exempt" for 2017, you MUST fill out a new W4. If you filed for exemption in 2016 you will be automatically set to the default of Single and 0 allowances as your exemption status expires on February 15, 2017.

### NOTES FROM THE TRAINING COORDINATOR

- Employees must bring in a copy of their new Driver's License once it has been renewed. Without a current copy on file, employees will be pulled from the schedule until this has been taken care of.
- · If employees are unable to attend trainings or in-services for any reason, they MUST contact their PC and/or Training Coordinator with at least a twenty-four hour notice OR you will still be charged.
- · Employees need to fax or bring a copy of their training certificates and/or In-Service sheets to the office once their training is completed.
- Employees need to make sure that FPH receives an updated copy of their auto insurance once it has been renewed, insurance company has changed, or whenever they get a new vehicle.
